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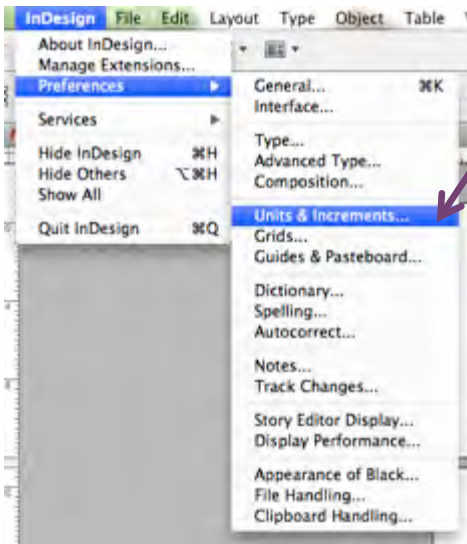
Putting Pages in InDesign

When all of your pages have been created in Photoshop it is time to place them into InDesign.

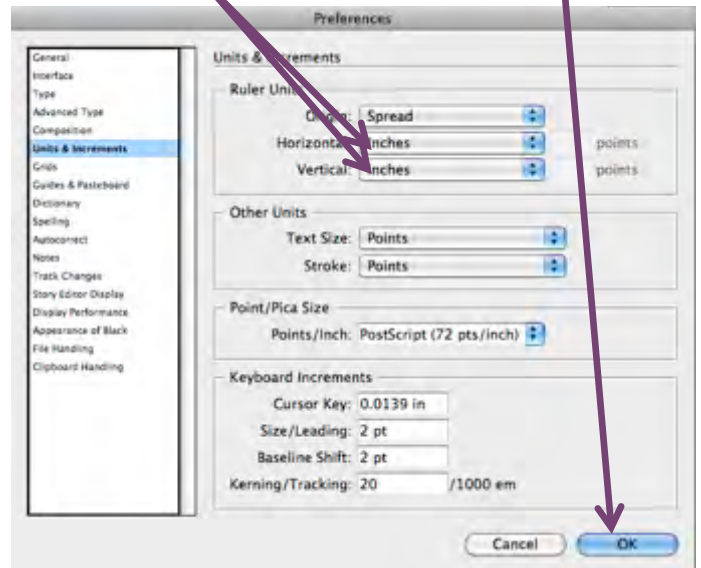
Open InDesign



You need to set some preferences in the program.
Go to: File → Preferences → Units and Increments



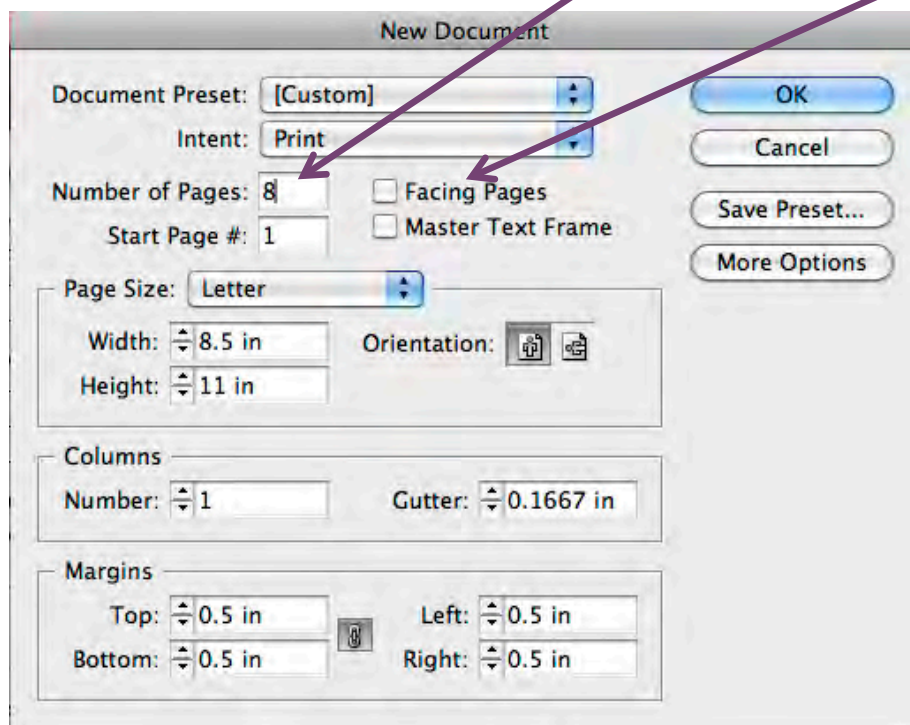
Make sure to change your horizontal and vertical ruler units to Inches. Choose: OK



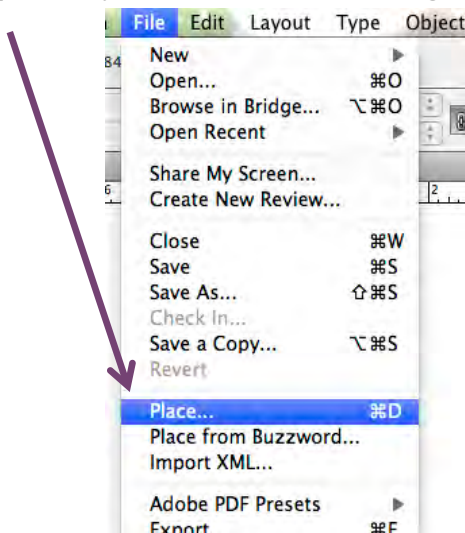
Create a new document.



This will open a new dialogue box. You want your document to have 8 pages, make sure Facing Pages is **not** checked.



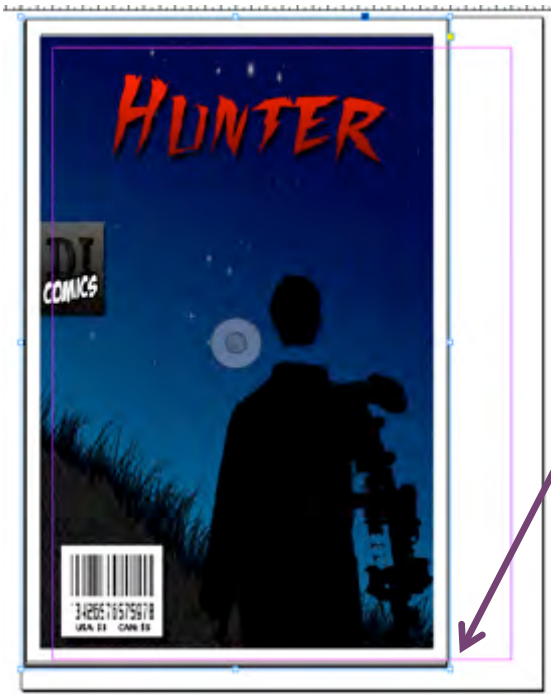
Your document will open and you can scroll down through your pages. With the first page in view, choose: File → Place



This will open a window for you to locate your file. Choose the first Photoshop page of your comic. This will then give you a small icon of your document and a pointer.



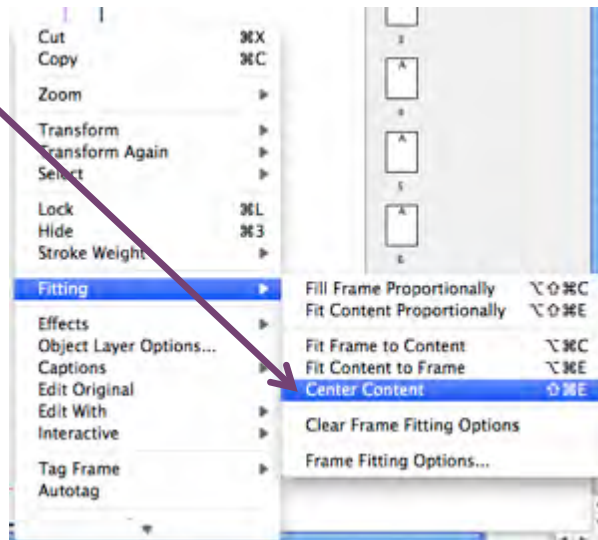
Click once and it will place your document full size on the page.



Click and drag the blue box out to fit the paper size.



Once you have made the blue bounding box as large as the page, right click (ctrl+click) and choose: fitting → center content



You will need to repeat this for each page of your comic book. Place them in order beginning with your cover. The last page of your InDesign file will be blank. This will be your back cover.

**Make sure you click off of the blue box before placing your next page or it will place right over the previous image.
